- Household garbage
- Yard waste
- Furniture
- Scrap metal

Items that cannot be accepted are:

- Tires
- Concrete, masonry products (bricks, pavers), rocks
- Sheetrock
- Household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, cleaners, thinners, aerosol cans, automotive fluids, batteries, fluorescent tubes, etc.)
- Electronics (television, computer, computer monitor, CRTs, separated circuit boards)
- Pharmaceuticals
- Sharps
- Appliances

Most classes will be held at Fire District 4 headquarters between 6:30 and 9:00 PM.

Residents of the City of Snohomish will have the opportunity to participate in this free event. Traditionally interest in this type of event is significant and space will be limited. Topics to be discussed will include Police and Fire procedure as well as local government issues. Due to the nature of the material presented, interested citizens will be required to complete an application and background questionnaire along with a basic background check performed by the police department.
