Snohomish Pumpkin River Race Returns!

A fall favorite returns to Snohomish on October 10th when those gorgeous orange gourds float down the river in a colorful race to the finish! Anyone can adopt a racing pumpkin (or two) for only \$5.00 each, at any "Official Pumpkin Adoption Station" for a chance to win cash and prizes including the grand prize: a \$600 children's bicycle from Snohomish Bicycles! Then, on race day watch pumpkins race down the Snohomish River!

Historic Downtown Snohomish and Snohomish Valley Festival of Pumpkins are teaming up with Snohomish County Volunteer Search & Rescue to produce this event in the "Pumpkin Capital of the Northwest"!



Snohomish Pumpkin River Race

Saturday, October 10th, 9:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Race begins at 10:00 a.m.

***All times are approximate and depend on tidal flow**

Watch it all from the Snohomish Riverfront Trail!

Here's how it works:

Through October 6th adopt racing pumpkins by visiting participating locations and purchasing \$5.00 adoption certificates (see next page for locations). There's no limit to how many you can adopt! (Note: adopters will not receive an actual pumpkin. All pumpkins will be in training until race day!) Adoption Station businesses are located in and around Snohomish. Adoption certificates are numbered, and corresponding numbers are placed on each adopted pumpkin before race time. Don't worry if you miss out on early adoption, a limited number of certificates will be available on race day starting at 9:30 a.m. at the Riverfront Gazebo on Avenue A.

On the big day, a Snohomish Volunteer Search & Rescue team plops the pumpkins in the river to float them on the tide toward the Avenue D Bridge. The first ten pumpkins "rescued" from the river at/near the bridge are the winners! Prizes include: \$50 and \$100 cash prizes, corn maze passes, a glass pumpkin ornament, a dining gift card, Halloween stationery, and the Grand Prize, a \$600 children's bicycle!

Pssst...this is a slow race and depends on the tide. You'll have plenty time once the little guys enter the water for a bite to eat or a bit of shopping while the pumpkins float downstream. Afterward, head out to your favorite Snohomish Pumpkin Farm for corn maze fun and u-pick pumpkins to take home. Find them all at www.festivalofpumpkins.com.
