Applicants Sought for Snohomish Public Safety Commission

Applicants are being sought to fill a vacancy on the City of Snohomish Public Safety Commission. The applications are due to the City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 10, at City Hall, 116 Union Avenue in Snohomish.

The Public Safety Commission member term runs for four years. The Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police, reviewing written recommendations to the Liquor Control Board for new or renewal applications. The Commission reviews law enforcement priorities, the coordination of Neighborhood Watch and Snohomish Police Foundation, coordination of the Fire District's Community Emergency Response Team, and related matters. Currently the Commission is setting direction for the instructional material for the upcoming fall Citizen Academy to help educate the public on safety related matters.

The Commission's membership shall consist of residents of the City or owners of businesses located within the corporate City limits. All City board and commission members are volunteers serving without compensation.

The vacancy was created by the recent resignation of Public Safety Commissioner Don Everest. The selected appointee will fill the balance of Mr. Everest's term which expires April 18, 2014. Mr. Everett has served as a Commission Member since April 2012.
