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## Social Media Policies Reviewed For Adoption by City Council

The City Council on May 16 directed staff to bring forward a resolution for adoption of new social media use policies. The resolution will be considered for adoption at the Council’s June 6 meeting.

Councilmembers generally supported the draft policies as presented and said they wanted to formally endorse them for implementation. In the future, the City may consider extending similar policies to other social media platforms as developed for its communications.

To ensure consistency with the proposed policies, staff would review all Facebook comments written by the public prior to allowing them to be posted. This may cause some delay before the comments appear on the page.

The new policies are designed to ensure in part that the City Facebook page does not violate state laws prohibiting use of City “facilities” for campaign purposes. State law broadly defines facilities to include city government media such as Facebook.

The draft policies would prohibit:

- Content that violates [Facebook’s terms of use](#);
- Postings that are prohibited under state law, such as comments that support or oppose political candidates or ballot propositions (RCW 42.52.180);
- Promotion or advertising commercial services, entities or products except as determined by the City to be essential to economic development;
- Religious statements, including comments that endorse or oppose any type of religion, religious opinions or activities;
- Profane or sexual language, violent, offensive, harassing, or threatening content;
- Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, socioeconomic status, national origin, physical or mental disability, sexual orientation, or other protected status;
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems or which incite or encourage the public to take actions contrary to law or public safety.
