

CITY OF SNOHOMISH WOOD STREET REPAIR PROJECT SUMMER 2017

UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION

Construction of the Wood Street Repair Project will begin in July 2017.

In the fall of 2016, there was a watermain break at Wood Street and Cypress Avenue. The water from the broken main undermined an area of Wood Street at the southeast corner and eroded the slope. The City Water Department repaired and replaced the watermain. This section of Wood Street and Cypress Avenue has been closed since then. In July, the City will begin the repairs to the slope and road. The repair of the slope will protect the existing utilities in the road which includes a gas pipe, 24-inch sewer trunkline and 6-inch water line. After the slope and road are repaired, Wood Street will be reopened as a one-way westbound road.

This project consists of slope repair, drainage improvements, conduit installation, paving, guardrail installation, clearing, grubbing, grading, erosion control, surface restoration, and other related items.

Expect traffic delays. This section of Wood Street and Cypress Avenue will remain closed during construction.
