


Final Movie In The Park For 2017

Do you have extra medicine you want to get rid of safely? Unused, unwanted, and expired medicines in your home pose a risk to you, your family and your community. Putting medicines in the garbage or flushing pills down the toilet are not safe disposal methods.

You can bring unneeded prescription medicines to the Snohomish Police Department during business hours. [Local police departments have been collection points](#) for many years. A [new program to expand collection points](#) in Snohomish County has just begun, but police stations will continue to be secure drop-off locations. The Snohomish Police Department is located at 230 Maple Avenue. It is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
