

Peracetic Acid Disinfection System Shoreline Substantial Development Permit NOTICE OF APPLICATION

City File #SL19-0001

PROPOSAL: Transition the City's effluent disinfection at the Wastewater Treatment Plant from chlorination to Peracetic Acid (PAA). The project will add an 80 square foot chemical metering building with PAA dosing equipment, controls, required safety features and HVAC, electrical, lighting, and plumbing. A 200 square foot canopy structure is proposed for PAA containment.


