**NOTICE TO BIDDERS
CALL FOR BIDS
CITY OF SNOHOMISH
PERACETIC ACID DISINFECTION SYSTEM**

This addendum shall become part of the Bid Documents and modifies the Bid Documents issued on November 13, 2019 for the City of Snohomish Peracetic Acid Disinfection System. Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum on the Bid Proposal form provided on page Bid-6. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to disqualification.

Please incorporate the following revisions to the Bid Documents:

CHANGES TO SECTION 1 – BID PROPOSAL

Bid Proposal Form (continued) on page Bid – 11:

1. Wrong year indicated, STRIKETHROUGH “2018” at the end of the first paragraph and WRITE “2019”.

Non-Collusion Affidavit on page Bid – 19:

1. Wrong year indicated, STRIKETHROUGH “2018” near bottom of page and WRITE “2019”.

Labor & Industries Contractor Training:

1. SUPPLEMENT Section 1 – Bid Proposal with the attached Labor & Industries new training requirement information (2 pages) and ADD the following to the Bidders Checklist on page Bid-4:
“10. Compliance with Training Requirements (RCW 39.04.350 & 39.06.020) _____”

CLARIFICATIONS TO SECTION 1 – BID PROPOSAL

Indemnification Addendum on page Bid – 14:

1. The Indemnification Addendum document only requires the Contractor’s signature for submittal with the bid.

Public Works Contract subsection; 7. Insurance, C) Minimum Scope of Insurance:

1. Builder’s Risk insurance and Contractors Pollution Liability insurance will be required by the City. All “non-checked” check boxes () on pages 5 of 19 through 7 of 19 in the Public Works Contract subsection for insurance shall be checked at the time of execution for the awarded Contract.

CLARIFICATIONS TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Section 11240:

1. Section 11240 - *PAA Building and Feed Equipment* is comprised of the “Peracetic Acid (PAA) Building, feed equipment, and auxiliary components” and is to be provided by Prominent as a complete package per Paragraph 2.01.A.

2. Prominent will provide everything listed, including the PAA Building, unless noted otherwise in Section 11240 or on the Drawings. Paragraph 2.03.A.4 allows for Prominent, and only Prominent, to submit for an “approved equal” for the PAA Building.
3. To reduce lead time and facilitate meeting the project timeline, the City has already paid for Prominent’s preparation of their submittal, which is anticipated to receive favorable review prior to the notice-to-proceed as indicated in Paragraph 1.03.A. The Contractor bears all other responsibility (e.g., ordering, purchasing, scheduling, furnishing, installing, commissioning, etc.) for the equipment as specified in the Contract Documents. Contractor Training

New Training Requirement for Businesses

Beginning July 1, 2019, all businesses are required to have training before bidding and/or performing work on public works projects. In 2018, the legislature passed [ESSHB 1673](https://app.leg.wa.gov/billssummary?BillNumber=1673&Year=2017) (<https://app.leg.wa.gov/billssummary?BillNumber=1673&Year=2017>) adding this training requirement to the responsible bidder criteria in [RCW 39.04.350](http://app.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=39.04.350) (<http://app.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=39.04.350>) and [RCW 39.06.020](https://app.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=39.06.020) (<https://app.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=39.06.020>).

Note: *You may continue working on a public works project that starts before July 1, 2019, and continues on or after July 1 without needing to meet this training requirement.*

Verify who needs training

Use the [Verify a Contractor](https://lni.wa.gov/licensing-permits/contractors/hiring-a-contractor/verify-contractor-tradesperson-business#contractors) (<https://lni.wa.gov/licensing-permits/contractors/hiring-a-contractor/verify-contractor-tradesperson-business#contractors>) tool to verify the training status for your company or other businesses. For projects starting on or after July 1, 2019, contractors and awarding agencies need to add this training requirement to the items you use to verify a business is responsible before hiring and working on public works projects.

Who's exempt?

You are exempt from this training requirement if you've been in business with an active Unified Business Identifier (UBI) number for 3 or more years **AND** have performed work on 3 or more public works projects.

Bidding on public works projects

You'll need to ensure you meet this training requirement before submitting a bid on or after July 1, 2019, for public works projects. Awarding agencies will be required to verify all contractors submitting bids meet this new requirement before awarding the contract.
