PROJECT NARRATIVE

February 6, 2020

This project is for the construction on a new building addition to the existing Boys & Girls Club of Snohomish County at 402 Second Street. This addition will be 40' X 80' with a recessed covered entry and will contain 3,000sf of new building area to be used as a teen activities center currently housed in the existing facility. This new addition will be on the northeast corner of the existing building and will be consistent with and an relocation of existing teen activity uses.

The addition will be located in a clear area between the existing building, the skate park, and the memorial drinking fountain. Only a portion of grass area and sidewalk will be demolished for the new construction. Building construction and material will match the existing facility. This will include cmu (Concrete Masonry Units) exterior wall with colors to match existing. These will be mainly natural gray color with accent columns in orange cmu and blue tiles in a vertical pattern. New roofing will match existing roofing with blue standing seam metal roof, and the gables will match with vertical corrugated metal. Roof slope will also match existing.
