ORDINANCE 2417

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH TO ESTABLISH THE  
DEPOSITS FUND (630).

WHEREAS, the City of Snohomish receives funds from time to time that include fees that are received by the City but must be transferred to the State of Washington or other parties; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Budget, Accounting, Reporting System requires these funds to be accounted for in a Fiduciary Fund for Custodial Activities;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH,  
WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Fund Creation.** Deposits Fund (630) is hereby created to receive fees and other monies that are classified custodial by the Washington State Budget, Accounting and Reporting System. The City Treasurer shall receive all such fees and deposit them in Deposits Fund (630).

**Section 2. Use of Fund Resources.** The City Treasurer shall remit the funds received in the Deposits Fund (630) to the parties due the collected fees.

**Section 3. Closing Fund.** Should the fund become obsolete, the City Treasurer shall present a closing Ordinance to the City Council.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such a decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to any other persons or circumstances.
