**ORDINANCE 2426**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH APPROVING THE  
PROPERTY TAX LEVY AT AN INCREASE OF 0.00%.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Snohomish has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Snohomish has properly given notice of the public hearings held November 2 and 16, 2021, to consider the City of Snohomish 2022 Real Estate Property Tax Levy; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that the City of Snohomish will require an increase in general property tax revenue from the previous year in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the City of Snohomish; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$1,299,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the population of this City is more than 10,000;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH,  
WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** An increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2022 tax year. The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$0.00 which is a percentage increase of 0.00%. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, solar, biomass, and geothermal facilities, and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

**Section 2.** Following adoption, the City Clerk is hereby directed to provide two certified copies of this ordinance to the Snohomish County Assessor.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2022.
