**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH ADOPTING THE
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE YEARS
2026 TO 2031 TO BE FILED WITH THE STATE SECRETARY OF
TRANSPORATION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.77.010, the City is required to annually review and update its Transportation Improvement Program for the ensuing six years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council reviewed the Transportation Improvement Program from the previous years and has considered the current City transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said proposed Transportation Improvement Program was held on the 17th day of June 2025, before the City Council of the City of Snohomish.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SNOHOMISH, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**

That the Transportation Improvement Program for the years 2026 to 2031, as set forth in Attachments “A” and “B” is found to be in the best interest of the City of Snohomish and consistent with the estimated revenues available for arterial construction together with such additional sums as the City may request from other sources, and the priorities as shown in Attachments “A” and “B” are hereby adopted.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to immediately file the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program adopted herein with the Secretary of Transportation for the State of Washington.


